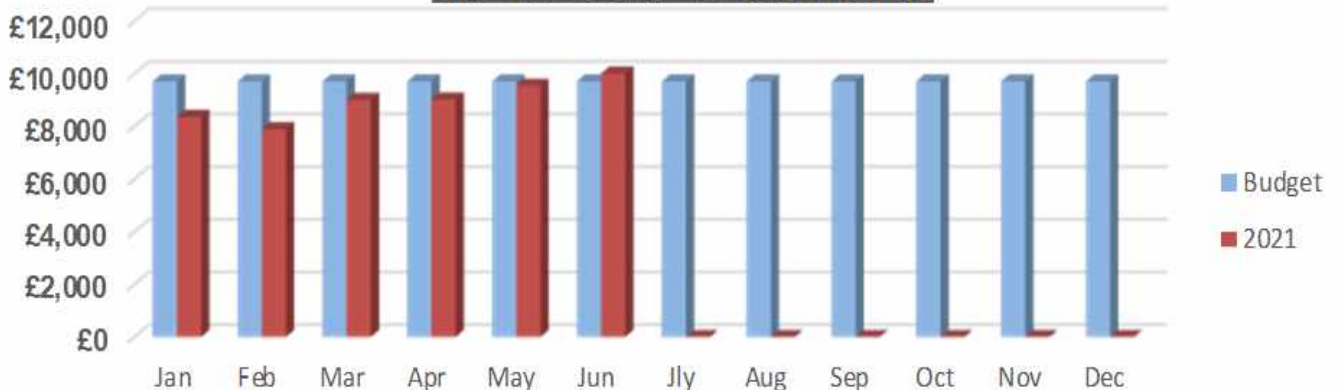

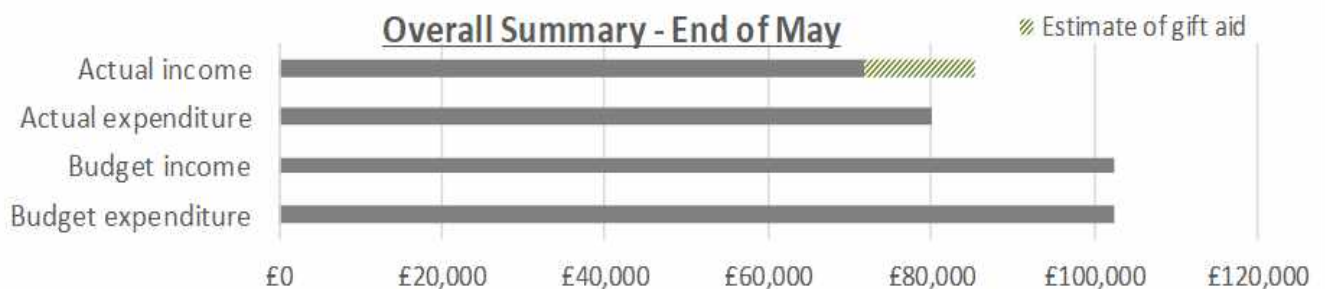
Finance Update

Just to keep everyone in the picture, the financial position of Emmanuel at the end of June is summarised on the picture below. After a somewhat shaky start to the year, free-will giving (the red bars) is now around the budgeted requirement (blue bars), and, as services start getting back to normal, other income streams as well as expenditure will increase. For this year, the extra cost of employing a Children's Worker and a Youth Worker will be met from previous years' savings.

The Promise of Isaiah 61: v3
