Child Contact Centre

SUN	Thank you for Suzanne Reed, Barbara Lillicrap and others who set up the Contact Centre at Emmanuel and for all the children and parents who have benefitted from it through the years. Thank you for similar centres throughout the country. We pray for estranged families to continue to be supported and helped to keep in contact, knowing how important family life is to growing children.
MON	Dear Lord, thank you for the small team that are running it now and the wisdom and experience they bring. Please inspire more volunteers to come forward as the centre is running at full capacity on Saturdays and even expanding to run a session during the week.
TUE	Thank you that the centre at Emmanuel has accreditation from the national body and is able to offer a free service to users. Thank you for the dads that at each session that help set out and put away the furniture. Thank you that the centre is recognised and appreciated by those able to make referrals from the court .
WED	We pray that as new people come forward to help they will find the induction and training beneficial and understand the need for guidelines and learn what is essential in running the centre.
THU	We pray for the atmosphere in the Centre to be welcoming and calm. A place where children can play safely and where adults will relax and feel at ease to relate to the children. We pray that the Centre will provide a place for contact to be established and confidence to grow, so that the Centre can be a means to access being arranged in a more natural environment.
FRI	Dear Father, we pray for all the families that have used the Centre, many of the children now adults, please bless them in their family lives going forward. Help us all in our relationships to appreciate one another and be ready to support each other through all the difficulties and misunderstandings of life.
SAT	Please dear Lord, bless all the families now using the Centre. Help them in every aspect of their lives. Please give them emotional healing and the tenacity to cope with the difficulties they face. Help all families facing separation at the moment, help the adults to be very mindful of the children's needs. Thank you for the provision through the law, the courts and social workers.
